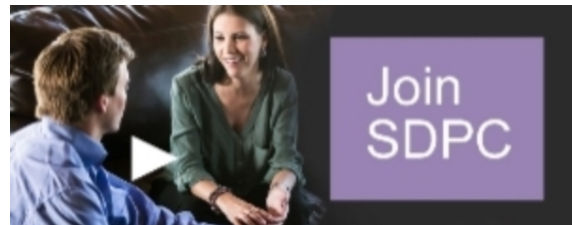
on April 26th is officially sold out. We regret to say that will not be able to accommodate any on-site registrations.
